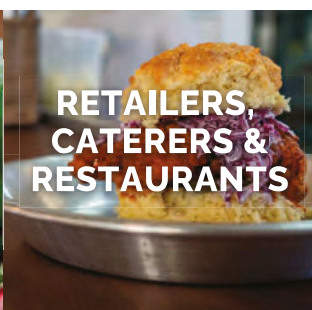

TIPS FOR A SAFE FARM TOUR EXPERIENCE

- Please leave pets at home (many of our farms are not dog-friendly)
- Don't rely on cell phones – much of our county does not have cell signal
- Wear appropriate shoes and clothing for the farms – closed toe shoes, no flip-flops
- Be careful of barbed wire & electric fencing
- Park only in designated areas on the farms
- Be careful driving on gravel roads and driveways

- Beware of Livestock Guardian dogs – these working dogs take their job of protecting livestock very seriously
- Beware of farm cats
- Do not pet animals behind fencing
- Do not feed animals without farmer permission
- Do not chase animals

the land. We like to tell folks “we grow carbon, grass and meat.” With approximately 100 ewes, their lambs, 10–15 cattle, several pigs, and a couple of goats, it sometimes feels like a 3 ring circus!

Bean Hollow Grassfed uses a system of grazing all the sheep, goats and cattle together in a “flerd.” The animals are grazed on small temporary parcels and moved every 1–4 days, creating greater plant utilization and longer recovery periods for the pastures. Over time, this enhances the soil health and plant diversity. Our goal is to extend our grazing season to a year round practice. We’re not there yet, but we’re getting closer.

Working with the Piedmont Environmental Council and the Smithsonian’s Virginia Working Landscapes, we are monitoring a broad number of soil and plant characteristics; along with bird and pollinator populations.



We will move sheep from one daily paddock to another at 11am each day.

Virginia Working Landscapes will have a self-guided tour about the ecological research being conducted here.

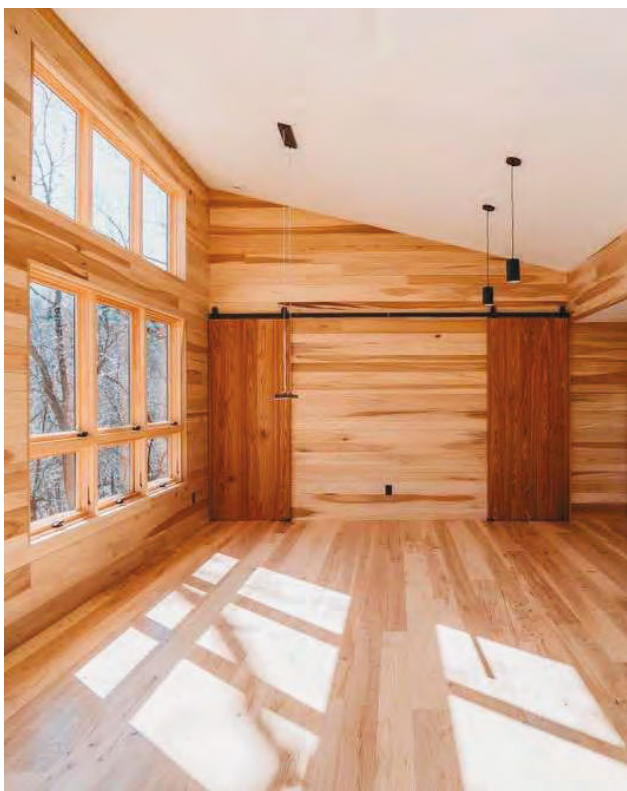

Blue Craft Farm is an art farm now in its second year of cultivation in Rapahannock County, owned and operated by Joneve Murphy. There are 20 different plant varieties in production. Through



chemistry and careful cultivation these plants can become paint, crayons, and other art supplies. Joneve's natural pigment journey began during quarantine with limited art supplies and plenty of time, starting with kitchen staples like turmeric and tea, then foraging for walnuts and elderberries, and eventually growing a dedicated palette of dye and pigment plants from seed. Through years of experimentation she has developed a range of plant based colors currently available as watercolor paints and fresh and dried plant material. Classes in paint and ink making as well as indigo dyeing are offered on the farm this summer through fall. There will be pigment and paint making demos as well as art supplies for sale during the tour.

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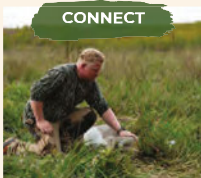

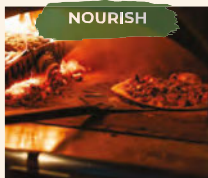

Chancellors Rock is an environmentally sustainable farm that also supports the native ecology of the Virginia Piedmont. With over 350+ acres in pasture and meadows, and 340+ acres in woodland, we are committed to regenerating the land through the adaptive grazing of our cattle, and protecting habitat for wildlife. The farm produces 100% grass fed beef pasture raised pigs, free range chickens and turkeys, vegetables, fruit, herbs and flowers from our French Intensive market garden. Chancellors Rock is also a lodging/event space with four houses for rent.

At 11 am, 1 pm and 3 pm, we will be giving a talk about our regenerative agricultural practices at the stable, as well as a guided tour of our market garden. The donkey/goat/chicken pasture adjacent to the stable is a highlight for children. For plant enthusiasts, maps with plant lists will also be available for self guided tours of the pond meadow and parterre garden.

Our farm store, located in the first two



stalls of the stable will also be open from 9 – 6 pm, with our beef, pork, chicken, eggs, and fresh vegetable, herbs, honey and flowers, as well as hand crafted soaps and balms.

When you get to a 3 car garage bay, you can park by the garage, or turn left and park by the stable where the farm store is located. Our rendezvous point will be at the stable and we will walk from there.



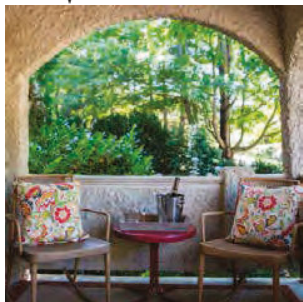


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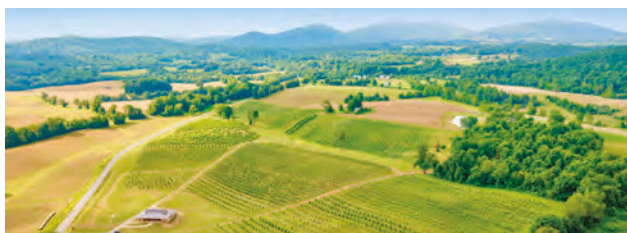

Nestled among breathtaking views of the Blue Ridge Mountains, our farm features more than 15,000 apple trees, a vibrant sunflower and zinnia meadow where guests can pick their own flowers, a pumpkin patch, and friendly farm animals to meet and pet.

Relax with a glass of our fresh-pressed apple cider or locally sourced hard cider while enjoying live bluegrass music. Be sure to visit our farm market, where you'll find many provisions grown/produced right here on the farm, other tasty snacks, and an array of locally-sourced goods.

Enjoy guided hayrides through the orchard (weather permitting), live bluegrass music from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m., pick-your-own flowers, and a curated collection of handcrafted goods from local artisans, including pottery and more. **New Iberia Kitchen** will be on site serving their delicious jambalaya.

The spirit of High Meadow Manor harkens back to America's rural agricultural traditions and lifestyle. A visit to High Meadow Manor will inspire farm enthusiasts of all ages and will be one you won't forget.
